We received the following message from the Chicago Rabbinical Council (CRC), that we thought would be of interest to our readers:

August 25, 2020

Please note that **Lucerne Farms** multiple varieties of 32 oz. **non-dairy coffee creamer** is missing the "D" (Dairy symbol). The product is dairy as it contains sodium caseinate (a milk derivative) as stated in the ingredient panel. According to the FDA this ingredient can be labeled "non-dairy", however, according to halacha it is actual dairy. Multiple varieties of the 32 oz coffee creamer are missing the D- Dairy designation and is **being sold in Chicago area supermarkets**. Other sizes correctly bear the OU D symbol.

The COVID-19 Guidelines for Congregation B'nai Torah

1. The shul will conform with public health recommendations of Marion County. The rules may change as the public health risk evolves.
2. The shul will be allowed to fill to 75% capacity while maintaining social distancing (at least 6 feet between individuals).
3. Within the building all individuals are required to wear a mask or face covering that covers the mouth and nose being mindful that doing so is for the benefit of others.
4. Anyone who has symptoms of illness, no matter how mild, should not attend services.
5. Minyanim will occur only in the main sanctuary at this time.
6. Attendees are expected to carefully wash their hands before coming to shul and maintain hand cleanliness while at shul.
7. Due to social distancing requirements, kiddushim will not be held for the time being.
8. Individuals at higher risk due to age or medical conditions should consult with their doctors to determine if attending services is advisable.
9. Individuals are strongly encouraged to bring their own siddurim from home or use one at shul they can ensure will not be used by others.
10. Children below Bar Mitzvah should remain at home to minimize disruption of social distancing
