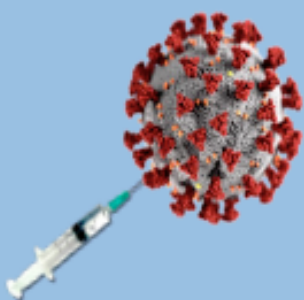

Allon Friedman, MD, is an Associate Professor of Medicine at Indiana University School of Medicine. He received his medical degree from McGill University and completed his training in medicine, nephrology, and nutrition at Tufts University and the US Department of Agriculture-Human Nutrition Center on Aging. Over the past year he has cared for a large population of patients with COVID-19 and is a site principal investigator for the multicenter STOP-COVID clinical study.

David Sanders is an Associate Professor of Biological Sciences at Purdue University. He joined the Markey Center for Structural Biology at Purdue in 1995. Professor Sanders is the author of two U.S. patents on novel gene - therapy delivery techniques. His work on the Ebola virus led to his participation in the U.S. Defense Threat Reduction Agency's Biological Weapons Proliferation Prevention Program. This past semester he taught the COVID-19 course at Purdue University.
