

Not only is one prohibited from eating chametz during the holiday of Pesach, one is also prohibited from owning or having chametz in his or her possession. Should it be too difficult to consume all of your chametz prior to the holiday, you may approach Rabbi Gettinger & authorize him to act as your agent in the sale of chametz on behalf of yourself, your family & your business. Since the sale will take place this year on Wednesday morning, April 5, 2023, please use the authorization form below, making sure it reaches the Rabbi no later than Tuesday morning, April 4.
