The Twin Emotions of Joy & Trepidation During the High Holy Day Season

Rabbi Yona Reiss is the Av Beth Din of the Chicago Rabbinical Council and a Rosh Yeshiva at the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary at Yeshiva University (RIETS), where he serves as the Rabbi L. Katz Chair in Professional Rabbinics. He is also the Segan Av Beth Din of the Beth Din of America in New York. He previously served as the Max and Marion Grill Dean of RIETS. Rabbi Reiss received Yoreh Yoreh and Yadin Yadin semicha from RIETS and is also a graduate of Yale Law School, where he served as a senior editor of the Yale Law Journal. He has published many articles on Jewish law and on American law, including in *Techumin*, the *Wall Street Journal* and the *New York Law Journal*.

Most recently, Rabbi Reiss published the book *Kanfei Yona*, a Hebrew language compendium of essays and responsa about contemporary issues in Jewish law and Talmudic topics. The books received approbations from leading rabbinic authorities throughout the world, including the two current Chief Rabbis of Israel.


